



Free ATV Safety Training

All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Safety Training will be conducted by certified *RiderCourse* instructors. The *ATV RiderCourse* provides a fast-paced, half-day, hands-on training session which includes pre-ride inspection, starting and stopping, quick turns, hill riding, emergency stopping and swerving, and riding over obstacles. Participants will also learn about protective gear, local regulations, places to ride and environmental concerns. Bring your friends, leaders and family!

Minimum Safety Gear Required

- Helmet
- Goggles
- Gloves
- Long sleeved shirt and long pants
- Shoes that cover your ankles

Machine Size Requirements

Ages 8 - 11	Under 70cc
Ages 12 - 15	70 - 90cc
Age 16 and older	Over 90cc

Can I Use My Own ATV?

Yes. If you do not have an ATV you may request special arrangements to have an ATV available at the training site. The machine size must adhere to the size requirements above.
