Why: Conduct chapter business. Conduct Association business. Discuss Halsey travel plan and other issues important to ATV and dirtbike riders in Nebraska. .

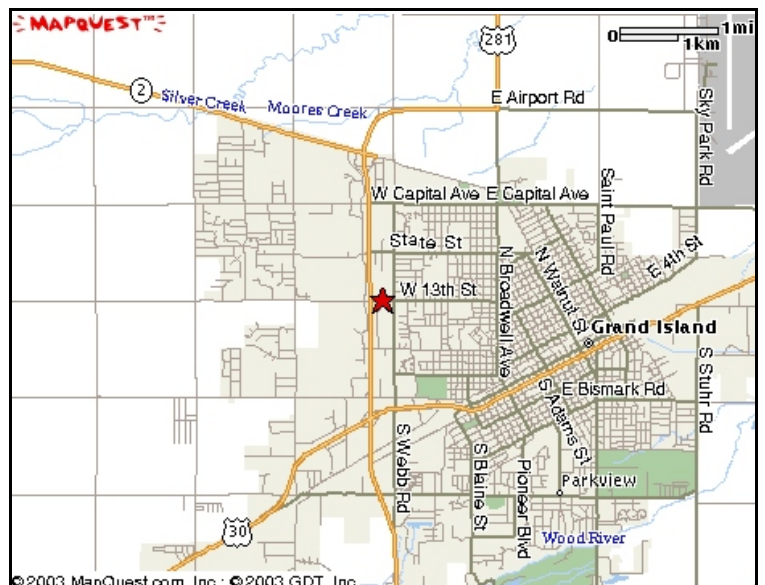
Who: ATV and dirtbike riders who are interested in the preservation of places to ride.
