WHO WE ARE

We are the Nebraska Off Highway Vehicle Association (NOHVA), a non-profit corporation established to benefit Nebraska's recreational All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), off-road motorcycle (dirtbike) and UTV/side-by-side riders. NOHVA's primary goals are preserve existing ATV/dirtbike/UTV trails and parks in Nebraska, promote responsible and safe ATV/dirtbike use, and to educate and serve the interests of recreational ATV and dirtbike owners.

WHAT WE DO FOR ATV AND DIRTBIKE RIDERS

NOHVA provides the critical funding and management skills required to keep Nebraska's ATV, Dirtbike and UTV parks and trails OPEN. We need your support to help us continue our effort to keep existing areas open and help develop new areas to ride!

NOHVA members operate chapters in eastern, central and west central Nebraska. Through our locally managed chapters, NOHVA provides an organization for ATV, Dirtbike and UTV riders to help manage and fund at five public ATV, Dirtbike and UTV parks and trail systems in Nebraska.

Unlike many states, Nebraska does not have a state-sponsored ATV, dirtbike and UTV trails management program. NOHVA volunteers help fill this void. Voluntary membership fee's paid by NOHVA members fund the operation of ATV, Dirtbike and UTV areas in Nebraska, and volunteers help with the management and maintenance of the parks and trails. Without the voluntary membership support from ATV, Dirtbike and UTV riders, the areas that are now open in Nebraska would not exist.

When people join NOHVA, they show their support to help keep Nebraska's existing parks and trails open, and to plan for new places to ride. If support is not adequate to operate existing ATV, dirtbike and UTV parks and trails, the

areas where people now ride will close. Without membership support and donations voluntarily provided by ATV, Dirtbike and UTV enthusiasts like you, it will be impossible to develop new places to ride.

In addition to helping fund, manage and maintain Nebraska's ATV, Dirtbike and UTV trails and parks, NOHVA chapters sponsor and fund family friendly and responsible minded activities such as jamborees, rodeos, parades, group rides and camp outs at various locations in Nebraska and surrounding states.

Since 1988, NOHVA members have worked with local, state and federal governments to help manage existing areas, find and develop places for Nebraskans and their families to ride. NOHVA members are involved with state and national trails groups and committees to meet our goal of supporting existing trails and finding new trails in Nebraska.

NOHVA can offer assistance to develop and manage places to ride anywhere in the state, as well as advise on safety and planning issues. NOHVA members are responsible for developing several new areas to ride over the last couple of years.

THE BENEFITS OF A NOHVA MEMBERSHIP

While NOHVA volunteers work to keep existing areas in Nebraska OPEN to ATV, Dirtbike and UTV riders, we strive to keep our members informed about news that can effect them!

Several parks and trails in Nebraska temporarily close and re-open one or more times each year. NOHVA sends information about these temporary closures and re-openings directly to our members via the US Mail and email. Our members only mailing program not only keeps NOHVA members informed, but saves our members time, gas and money as they know when parks and trails are open and closed.

NOHVA members can attend our members only Jamborees and other events.

In addition to our direct mailings, NOHVA members stay informed of news, events and places to ride with our quarterly magazine, the "Nebraska OHV Advisor".

NOHVA members also receive our annual members only "Nebraska Ride Guide". The "Nebraska Ride Guide" features up-to-date information about where to ride in and near Nebraska. The Ride Guide also includes special edition members only trail maps, trails descriptions, and camping information.

Participating ATV, Dirtbike and UTV retailers allow special NOHVA member discounts, with a current membership card.

I / We understand that riding an ATV, dirtbike or UTV can be very dangerous resulting in serious injury and / or death and / or property damage. I acknowledge and assume all risk of injury or death to myself or a member of my family and the possibility of damage to our property at any time while on or near any land, place or area that is owned, leased, managed, patrolled or used by the Nebraska Off Highway Vehicle Assn. (NOHVA), TBQ Sport Club, Inc., the USDA Forest Service Nebraska National Forest, Loup Power District, the Nance County Sheriff's Department, the City of Alliance, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. I / We agree to thoroughly inspect any of the lands managed, owned or otherwise by the Nebraska Off Highway Vehicle Assn. (NOHVA), TBQ Sport Club, Inc., the USDA Forest Service Nebraska National Forest, Loup Power District, the Nance County Sheriff's Department, the City of Alliance, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers or places or areas that I / we enter to insure that they are safe and reasonably suited for my / our use. If, after a thorough inspection of places or areas where NOHVA and it's chapters are involved with, and if any of the places or areas are found to be unsafe or not suited for my / our use, I / we will vacate the unsafe or unsuitable land, places or areas and immediately advise NOHVA and / or and the area land owners, managers or chapter officials of these un-safe or unsuitable conditions. I / We hereby release and wave my right to sue or make any claim whatsoever against the Nebraska Off Highway Vehicle Assn. (NOHVA), TBQ Sport Club, Inc., the USDA Forest Service Nebraska National Forest, Loup Power District, the Nance County Sheriff's Department, the City of Alliance, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. , any of its officers or Directors, any related organizations, law enforcement agencies, any organizers of NOHVA events or activities, any landowners that allow NOHVA to lease, manage, patrol or use their land and their relatives while taking part in any NOHVA related activity. **All applications for membership are subject to approval.
